



Leave No Trace Trainer Course

The registration deadline is hard deadline as this allows us time to order adequate quantities of materials for the course.

This is an informative, practical, and fun 16-hour, overnight course on the ethics and practice of minimum-impact recreation. This course is designed to train Scouts BSA (age 14 and older), Venturers, Sea Scouts, summer camp staff, crews attending treks/sessions at any of the BSA High Adventure Bases, advanced training course instructors (Wood Badge, Powder Horn, NYLT, etc.) and Adult Scout leaders in all program areas to serve as Leave No Trace Trainers for Scouting and the general public. Each Trainer course is taught by a team of nationally recognized Leave No Trace Master Educators, so your Trainer standing is recognized nationally by BSA's partner agency, the Leave No Trace Center for Outdoor Ethics.

COURSE CONTENT

- Instruction on how to minimize impacts in the outdoors by making informed and conscientious decisions.
- Experiencing hands-on activities and games to illustrate the importance and meaning of the Leave No Trace principles.
- Exploring effective ways to teach others about Leave No Trace, including teaching presentations by all participants. Participants are required to lead a 15 minute presentation on an assigned Leave No Trace Principle or other impact topic. Further details and resources will be provided after registration closes.
- Satisfaction of certain requirements for the Outdoor Ethics Action Award (scouts and scouters) and the National Medal for Outdoor Achievement (Scouts)

COURSE DETAILS

- **Registration deadline:** March 6, 2021
- **Arrival:** Friday, April 9 at 5:30 – 6:30 pm
- **Course Starts:** Friday, April 9 at 7:00 pm
- **Departure:** Sunday, April 11 by noon
- **You must attend and participate in all sessions which run through the evening.**

Cost: Registration is \$70 paid to the Occoneechee Council using the online registration system. This fee covers all food, snacks and beverages, training equipment, Leave No Trace program and training materials, certificate of recognition as a LNT Trainer from The Center, and extensive educational support to conduct your own Leave No Trace Awareness Workshop

Pre-requisites:

- A desire to learn more about Leave No Trace by being an active participant in the course.
- Complete the Online Awareness Course at <https://lnt.org/get-involved/training-courses/online-awareness-course/> prior to coming to class and submit the training certificate.

Facilities: We will be primitive camping at the Picnic Area at Camp Reeves. Half of the course will be taught indoors (Reeves Headquarters) with the other portion being outdoors, weather permitting.

COVID Procedures: As always, the safety of our attendees and staff is our top priority. Our course size will be limited to a maximum of seven (7) participants to maintain social distancing in the classroom and masks will be required while in the classroom.
