

We are currently following what is coming out of the Gov. Office and what the schools are doing. The best news is that the kids are back in school and this was the single biggest step to the road back to normal.

- Our current plan is to NOT eat in shifts. With the dining hall capacity of 800 we are still at 50% capacity.
- Social distancing has been reduced in schools to 3 feet.
- Handwashing will be encouraged; hand sanitizer will be available throughout camp.
- We will ask that everyone wears a mask indoors only.
- All our classes will have caps and when reached Tentaroo will close it down.
- 99% of our senior staff have the Vaccination. Staff members under the age of 18 are working with their parents on a decision.
- Admin, Health Lodge, Grand Lodge, Sullivan Center buildings have had Reme-Halo UV Light Systems installed in the ventilation systems.
- All buildings will be used.
- We no longer require 14-day temperature checks. We are asking everyone to use the Pre-Event Medical Checklist.
- Campsites are open enough to allow for two troops to share.

We are still monitoring state announcement and maintain an active relationship with the Moore Co. Health Department. As we get closer to camp more people will be vaccinated and events will be larger, and we should be closer to normal.
