COVID-19 Policies for District and Unit Level Events: Council Level Activities must follow the full Camp Mitigation Plan Effective Aug 3, 2020 subject to change regarding state regulations

- No one is allowed in any buildings. All buildings are closed, minus the bathhouses.
- The unit/district is required to have a cleaning crew that follows the mitigation strategies outlined.
- Units/Districts must adhere to the current State group gathering numbers for all activities and campsites.
- **Everyone** in camp must turn in a Pre-Camp Health Screening form to the OSR representative upon check-in to camp.
- Upon checking in you will be issued the following items that must be returned upon checking out of camp. There is a \$100 fee for camp wide District events and a \$25 use fee for Unit events for the usage of these items. It is required that you use the items provided for you by Occoneechee Scout Reservation. The items that are being used have been approved through the Moore County Department of Health and Human Services.
 - Temperature guns
 - Temperature sheets (everyone must be checked upon arrival by unit/district leadership and daily while in camp, By Leader)
 - Sprayers (Solution mixed by Ranger)
 - Cleaning supplies (if more are needed, please ask the Ranger for them)
 - Hand Sanitizer at each bath house and program area
 - Hand Soap at each bath house
- Units/Districts must have a designated medical person.
- Masks that cover the nose and mouth are required to be worn at all program areas except for the waterfront. Social Distancing must be employed.
- Campsites are for single unit usage only.
- There are no multi-touch activities of program equipment.
