Occoneechee Council Merit Badge Counselor Policy

- Occoneechee Council renews Merit Badge Counselors (code 42), annually in April of each year. Registration for
 this Council position will be from May 1st of the current year to April 30th of the following year. Counselors are
 required to be individually responsible for submitting their own renewal requirements. Merit Badge counselors
 must be at least 18 years old and of good character.
- Effective April 1, 2023 Occoneechee MB Counselor may register for a maximum total of 20 unique merit badges annually. Additionally once you are approved, you cannot replace them with different badges, except during the annual renewal, in the month of April.
- Effective April 1, 2023 The former merit badge selection form, has been superseded by the new Occoneechee MB counselor registration survey. ← click to register

Merit Badge Counselor Registration or Renewal Requirements

- New, 1st time Occoneechee MB counselors must submit a fully completed <u>BSA Adult application</u>.
 MB Counselors are Council level positions (code 42) and need only the approval signature of a District Executive, or their District Advancement Chair. Unit level approval signatures are not valid. There is no fee for MB counselors.
- New or renewal MB counselors must complete the new Occoneechee MB counselor registration survey. Do not use or submit BSA form 34405. This survey form is new for 2023.
- MB Counselors who have no other current Scouting registered positions, shall submit the <u>additional disclosures</u> and <u>background check authorization form</u>. This is required since 2020, only one submission is required.
- A Youth Protection training completion certificate must be submitted annually, with all registrations or renewals.
 YPT training date should be on or after May 1, 2022 to be registered or renewed.

 Online training is available in the BSA Learn center at My.Scouting.Org (use Google Chrome browser)
- MB counselor position specific training must be complete. One of the following three options are allowed:
 - Classroom Merit Badge Counselor Orientation (D76) -or-
 - o Online MB Counselor training: SCO_402, SCO_403, SCO_407, SCO_415, SCO_416, and SCO_417 -or-
 - Online MB Counselor training: SCO_431, SCO_433, SCO_430, SCO_435, SCO_448, and SCO_434 -or-
 - CURRENT MB Counselor training: SCO 471, SCO 472, SCO 474, and SCO 486
 Online training is available in the BSA Learn center at https://training.scouting.org Choose the Merit Badge Counselor Position Specific Training from the catalog. (use Google Chrome browser)
 Any one, of the four training options above, are acceptable to be a trained MBC.

Important requirements:

- 14 Merit badges, require certifications that must be certified, to be registered for that badge. See the <u>Guide to Advancement</u>, section 7.0.1.1, on the BSA national website, for details on the required certifications for each of these badges. Counselors who do not submit the required supporting certifications, will not be registered for that badge. You will be able to upload these items with your survey.
- NEW Effective March 23, 2023, merit badge counselors YPT training must not expire before April 30, the following year. Therefore you must ensure your YP training is current for the entire annual registration period.
- Be recognized as having the skills and education in the merit badge subjects covered and hold any required qualifications and training as outlined in the Guide to Safe Scouting or the Guide to Advancement—or use others so qualified. You will be prompted to list your qualifications for every badge you request approval to counsel.
