On Saturday, Lions, Tigers, Wolves & Bears (as well as anyone staying at Camp Durant for the day) will enjoy games, rocket building and launching, exhibits, crafts, and demonstrations. Webelos attending the Webelos-Only event at Camp Reeves will enjoy a day in the life of a Scout (formerly Boy Scouts). On Sunday an Interfaith Service is open for all to attend. Every paid participant will receive a commemorative patch.

Scout Law

Registration

- ❖ Registrations is from Feb 1- through midnight on Apr 5.
- ❖ Registration and payment must be completed by midnight April 5. No exceptions.
- ❖ No registration after midnight April 5. No exceptions!
- ❖ Registration fees for Lions, Tigers, Wolves, and Bears is \$25.
- ❖ Registration for Webelos is \$35 (this includes Saturday lunch for the Webelos and for any adults hiking to Reeves on Saturday.)
- ❖ Registration fee per adult is \$10.00.
- ❖ Registration fee for siblings is \$5.
- ❖ All those attending must be registered. Do not bring anyone (family or scouts) not registered.
- ❖ All those registered will receive a confirmation email sent to the email address provided at registration. This email will confirm the number of people registered, meals and T-shirt orders.
- ❖ Report errors to the Council Office at (919) 872-4884. Do not call to add any registrants.

The Webelos-Only Program

- ❖ Advanced registration required. (select this option at the time of registration)
- ❖ Saturday 8am- 4pm | Camp Reeves (we will start and end at Durant)
- ❖ NO SIBLINGS ARE PERMITTED AT THE WEBELOS-ONLY PROGRAM AT CAMP REEVES.
- ❖ Schedules and additional information will be provided at check-in.

Vehicles

- ❖ Personal Vehicles are allowed to drive around Camp Durant
- ❖ Friday & Saturday BEFORE 8 am and AFTER 5 p.m.
- ❖ For the safety of our scouts, no driving personal vehicle around Camp Durant between 8am- 5pm (EXCEPTION- Emergency Vehicles, Camp Ranger & Exhibitors)
- ❖ ANY CUBOREE PARTICIPANT CAN CHECK IN AS EARLY AS 2 PM ON FRIDAY.

- ❖ Saturday Dinner is available: \$8 per person | Grand Lodge.
- ❖ Meals must be RESERVED AND PAID for by APRIL 5.
- ❖ ALL OTHER MEALS ARE ON YOUR OWN

Campsites

- ❖ Be a good neighbor! Each campsite will have multiple Cub Scout Packs. The site must be shared.
- ❖ Parking is limited at each site. Be aware Camp Durant is likely to be muddy due to all the rain we've had since January.
- ❖ When parking, ensure emergency vehicles can pass through camp for the safety of all attending.
- ❖ Each campsite will have platforms for summer camp tents. You are welcome to set your tent on the platforms if it fits.
- ❖ Some campsites are smaller than others. Plan to share space so all tents can fit and our youth can have a fun time!
- ❖ The dining shelter is for everyone! Share with your pack and other families at your campsite.
- ❖ Youth are excited making sleeping Friday night difficult. Saturday will be a busy day and they will sleep on Saturday. Thankfully :)
- ❖ Be a good campsite neighbor and make new friends!
