



We are currently following what is coming out of the Governor's Office and Moore County Environmental Health.

- Admin, Health Lodge, Grand lodge, Sullivan Center buildings have Reme-Halo UV Light systems installed in the ventilation systems.
- Social distancing will be done to best of the ability of the staff and participants
- Handwashing will be encouraged; hand sanitizer will be available throughout camp.
- We will ask that everyone wears a mask indoors.
- We will need all staff and participants to fill out the Pre-Event Medical Checklist. If you aren't feeling well, please do not come to camp.
- If you feel like you may have been exposed to COVID-19, we ask that you have a negative COVID test prior to attending camp.
- Should someone test positive either during their time at camp or within 2 weeks of attending an event, all participants and staff will be notified.

- While we would like to sleep everyone 2 to a cabin/tent. This is not always possible due to the number of participants. We recommend sleeping head to foot with the others in your cabin/tent. If you would prefer to camp separately, please bring the required equipment needed.
